

MEXART STUDENT AGREEMENT

The following guidelines are designed to ensure that MexArt is a happy, safe, and productive community for everyone. Experience has shown that it's very unlikely that these issues will affect you. However, it is necessary that we have this agreement for mutual understanding. These are the conditions under which we accept your participation. Read them carefully. On the first full day of the program, we will have a meeting with all participants where you will be asked to reaffirm your commitment to these guidelines.

*Violation of the following guidelines will result in the **immediate dismissal** from the program without a refund of the tuition. Transportation costs and arrangements will be the responsibility of parents or parental appointed guardians.*

1. The use or possession of alcohol, cigarettes, marijuana, or any non-prescribed drug is prohibited.
2. Physical violence, actual or the threat of, is prohibited.
3. Sexual activity and/or sexual harassment are prohibited.
4. The destruction of or theft of others' belongings is prohibited. Practical jokes are considered a violation of student rights and are also strictly prohibited.
5. Dyeing of hair, piercing, tattooing, or any other significant changing of appearance is strictly prohibited.
6. During orientation, a map of San Miguel is presented. Boundaries for travel are drawn and must be adhered. Participants are able to travel, only during appointed times, in pairs within the boundaries. MexArt chaperones must be present outside of the boundaries.

MexArt seeks to create a supportive environment that encourages personal growth and creativity. Directors and staff are experienced in dealing with teens and with setting reasonable limits. However, repeated or multiple violations of the following guidelines will result in dismissal from the program. Transportation costs and arrangements for early dismissals will be the responsibility of parents or parental appointed guardians.

1. All rooms are single-sex, private spaces for their residents. Opposite sex visitors are not permitted in rooms.
2. Participant attendance at MexArt activities is mandatory unless the absence is permitted by a director as a result of illness.
3. Safety rules at all program areas (i.e. art studios, classrooms) are absolute.
4. Foul language and the inappropriate use of language that insults or belittles another student or staff member is not permitted.
5. Students must sign in before curfew. Violators may be dismissed or have a decrease in privileges.

General Guidelines:

Valuables must be kept at the Cross house. Valuables stored or left in casitas or public spaces are the responsibility of the owner. MexArt nor Casa Crayola are responsible for loss, theft, damage or items left behind..

Potentially dangerous items such as knives, fireworks, or weapon-like objects should not be brought to or purchased during MexArt.
